Framework for Research Paper Submission and Presentation

General Guidelines for All Presentations

- · Research-Papers must be original and unpublished.
- Above-mentioned Research Tracks are only indicative in nature.
 Latest systematic research-papers or review articles, which are
 intensively, extensively or comprehensively inter-linked to such
 topics are invited for paper-persentations, discussions, and
 submissions for publication.
- Extended Abstracts should not exceed 800 words and must include Author(s) Affiliation, Research aper Title, Research Objectives, Research Methodology, Key Findings and Conclusion, followed by 5-6 Key-words.
- Full papers should be submitted in APA format, in around 3000 5000 words, in English or Hindi, and should include:
 - Title of the Research
 - Simple Abstract (in around 300-500 words)
 - Keywords (around 5-6)
 - Introduction
 - Review of Literature
 - Gaps in Existing Research
 - Problem-Statement
 - Research Objectives
 - Methodology of the Research
 - Data Analysis (tables, charts, if any)
 - Key Research Findings
 - Scope of the Research
 - Significance of the Research
 - Limitations of the Research
 - Implications of the Research
 - Directions for Future Research
 - Conclusion
 - Bibliography
 - Annexures (if any)

Deadlines

Extended Abstract Submission: 10th February 2025

Full Research Paper Submission: 20th February 2025

Three Formats for Research Paper Presentation

1. POSTER PRESENTATIONS

- Posters should measure 36" x 48" (portrait orientation).
- Content to include: Title, Objectives, Methods, Results, Conclusion, and/or QR code linking to the full paper.
- Authors must be present at their Posters during allocated time slots for discussion.
- Virtual poster presenters will upload high-resolution PPT or PDF with their pre-recorded 3 to 5 minute audio summaries.

2. ORAL PAPER PRESENTATIONS

- Each paper presenter will have 12 minutes (8-minute presentation + 4-minute Q&A).
- Use of PowerPoint presentations (PPT) is optional.
- Offline presenters must bring their presentation files on a USB drive, while virtual presenters will share their screens via the virtual platform.
- All Research Paper Presentations will be evaluated by a panel of experts based on clarity, originality, and research contribution for selection to Awards or Publications.

3. VIRTUAL PAPER PRESENTATIONS

- Virtual presenters will join live or submit pre-recorded 8-minute presentations.
- Pre-recorded submissions should be sent by 1st March 2025.
- Live Q&A sessions will follow all presentations to ensure engagement.

Social Recognition Awards: Honoring exceptional women for their significant contributions to society and the world.

Best Paper Awards: Top 3 research papers in each track will receive certificates, prizes, and recognition.

Certificates of Participation: To be provided to all participants and paper presenters.

- **1. ISBN Edited Book:** Full papers will be published in English and Hindi.
- **2. Indexed Journals:** Selected papers will appear in peer-reviewed journals of national and international repute.

How to Reach

To reach Maharaja Suhel Dev University in Azamgarh, you have a few options:


- By Air: The distance between the airport and the university in Manduri is roughly 15 kilometers. Varanasi International Airport is around 100 kilometers distant and is the closest International airport to the location. To go to Azamgarh, you may either take a bus or rent a cab from that location.
- By Train: Azamgarh Railway Station provides excellent connections to important cities including Delhi, Lucknow, Varanasi, Gorakhpur, etc. You have the option of taking a bus, cab or an auto-rickshaw to get to the campus from the railway station.
- By Road: Azamgarh is linked to Lucknow, Varanasi, Gorakhpur, Ghazipur, Mau and other important cities by the Purvanchal Expressway. To get to the University by car, just take the Azamgarh exit and go on the local roads. Travelers may use of bus services that stop at Azamgarh city along the Purvanchal Expressway. Getting to the institution is as easier through Azamgarh-Ghazipur Highway.

Places to Visit

There are many fascinating sites to see in and around Azamgarh. Here are a few suggestions: On the outskirts of town, the **Bhawarnath shrine**, is a renowned Shiva shrine. Ancient buildings like as the Thakurji Temple and the Raja Sahib Mosque, as well as sarees designed in the Benarasi style, have brought **Mubarakpur** fame. An ancient mausoleum with distinctive design features: the Daulat Ibrahim Khan Tomb. **Awantikapuri Dham** is a sacred lakeside temple with mythological roots. A place of spiritual solace where visitors might have their heart's desires granted: **Durvasha Rishi Ashram**. The **black pottery of Nizamabad** is world-renown. The pond and fort constructed by King Haribans are the main attractions of **Mehnagar**. Ghosi is a town that has great historical importance. The Ganga River provides tranquility and beautiful scenery. Another important historical site is **Gadhwar Fort**.

Nearby city **Varanasi**, at around 100 km, has great retreats like **Sarnath**, the place where the Buddha spoke his first sermon is a sacred site for Buddhists. Not far from Azamgarh, in **Gorakhpur**, you find the world-renown **Gorakhnath Temple**, which is devoted to Guru Gorakshnath. Approximately 100 km distant is the city of **Jaunpur**. Approximately 160 kilometers from Azamgarh is **Triveni Sangam**, **Allahabad /Prayagraj**, where the three rivers -Ganga, Yamuna, and the legendary Saraswati - meet.
